***NOTE:** If you choose 60" (150cm) wide fabric for the Kilt, purchase one-half of the yardages shown above for 45" (115cm) fabric. Refer to the note about using 60" (150cm) fabric in Step 1 of the Kilt instructions.

NOTE: The selvage edge of the fabric will show at the hem of the Kilt, so further hemming will not be required. For this reason, it is preferable to choose fabric with cleanly woven selvages.
