



K4251 Misses' Jackets and Tank

XS-S-M-L-XL

Jackets have raglan three-quarter length sleeves with shoulder darts. Front and hem variations. Knit scoop neck tank has neckline and armholes finished with narrow hems. **A:** Overlapping fronts with frog closure. **B:** Open fronts, contrast sleevebands.

FABRICS: A, B: Designed for light to medium weight wovens. C: Designed for stretch knits only with 35% stretch across the grain.

Suggested Fabrics: A, B: Linen, challis, cotton blends, broadcloth. C: Jersey, interlock.

NOTIONS: A, B: One Package of 1/2" (1.3 cm) Single Fold Bias Tape. A: Frog Closure.

4" (10 cm) of Knit Fabric should stretch to at least here.

USE FABRIC WITH 35% STRETCH ACROSS THE GRAIN
