POT HOLDER, MITT, CASSEROLE CARRIER

Fabrics: Designed for lightweight woven fabrics such as: Cotton and Cotton Types.

Interfacing: Batting or insulating fleece.

Notions:

A: 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yds. (1.3m) of $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3cm) double fold bias tape.

B: $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. (0.7m) of $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3cm) double fold bias tape.

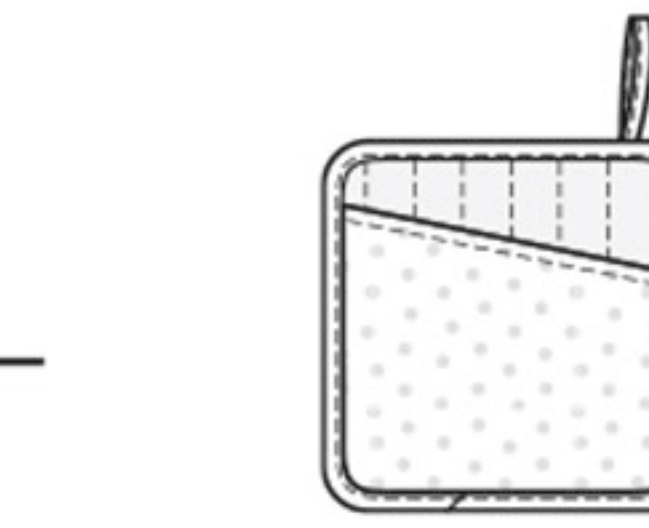
C: 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds. (5.3m) of $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3cm) double fold bias tape, two wooden spoons with 15" (38cm) handles.

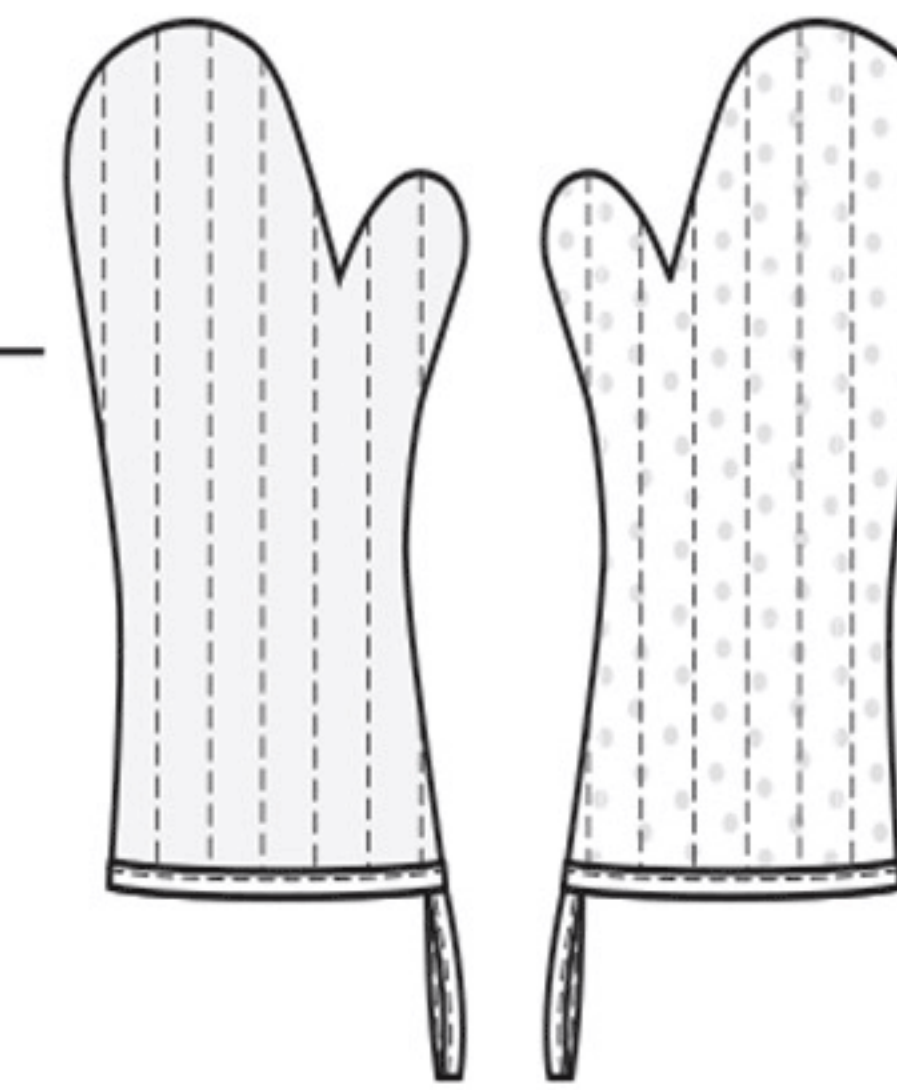
Fabric 1 (Potholder): 22" x 11" (56cm x 28cm) Remnant

Fabric 2 (Pockets): 11" x 11" (28cm x 28cm) Remnant

Interfacing: 11" x 11" (28cm x 28cm) Remnant

Fabric 2 (Contrast): 11" x 17" (28cm x 43cm) Remnant

Fabric 3 (Lining): 22" x 17" (56cm x 43cm) Remnant

Interfacing: 22" x 17" (56cm x 43cm) Remnant

Casserole Carrier C - 12" x 17 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " (31cm x 44cm x 9.5cm)

Fabric 1 (Carrier): 45"* - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds. (115cm* - 1.6m)

Fabric 2 (Contrast): 45"* - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds. (115cm* - 1.6m)

Interfacing: 45"* - 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yds. (115cm* - 1.6m)

Note: Remaining quilted fabric can be used to make two mitts.
